The 2010 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC once again emphasize the need for high-quality CPR, including • A compression rate of at least 100/min (a change from "approximately" 100/min) • A compression depth of at least 2 inches (5 cm) in adults and a compression depth of at least one third of the anterior- posterior diameter of the chest in infants and children (approximately 1.5 inches [4 cm] in infants and 2 inches [5 cm] in children).

In October 2010 the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) and the American Heart Association (AHA) released changes to the Guidelines for CPR & Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC). The objective of the changes is to make it easier for rescuers and health care providers alike to learn, remember and perform better CPR.

With the 2010 CPR Guidelines Push hard push fast

The steps for CPR have not changed since 1954 when it was first introduced by Dr. Peter Safar. The order of the different steps for performing CPR has always been A-B-C, which represents the order airway, breathing, and compressions. This was the accepted best practice up until 2010 when the American Heart Association made revisions to the order of the steps.

CPR for an Infant If providing CPR for an infant the ratio of compressions to breaths remains the same but the method of performing compressions changes. For an infant you should use 2-3 fingers in the center of the chest on the lower half of the breast bone to compress the chest about 1 ½".
