The fetal and neonatal erythrocyte differs from the adult erythrocyte with regard to life span, membrane structure, hemoglobin (Hb), and metabolic content. The life span of the erythrocyte in a healthy term infant is 60 to 80 days and in a preterm infant is 30 to 50 days. 1 This time span is significantly shorter than the 120 days of an adult red blood cell.
