Phylum Annelida Phylum Annelida includes segmented worms. These animals are found in marine, terrestrial, and freshwater habitats, but a presence of water or humidity is a critical factor for their survival, especially in terrestrial habitats. The name of the phylum is derived from the Latin word *annellus*, which means a small ring.

Annelids include earthworms, marine worms, such as the ones shown in Figure 25.22, and parasitic leeches. All of these worms are different from flatworms and roundworms because they are segmented and have a coelom. Most annelids also have a larval stage that is similar to that of certain mollusks, suggesting a common ancestor.
