CANS Scores -Level of Strengths 0= A zero represents a significant area of strength for a child, it is the best rating a child can get in the area of strengths. 1= a score of 1 implies a good strength that can be made even stronger. 2 and 3= Scores of 2 and 3 indicate a lack of strength in a particular area.

A Guide for Using the CANS with Clients and Their Families ...
The CANS has demonstrated reliability and validity. With training, any one with a bachelor's degree can learn to complete the tool reliably, although some applications require a higher degree. The average reliability of the CANS is 0.75 with vignettes, 0.84 with case records, and can be above 0.90 with live cases.

Child and Adolescent Needs & Strengths Tool Training ...
Use of the CANS requires training and certification to ensure consistency of ratings across users. Therefore, you must successfully complete training and certification prior to using the tool in your work. Typically, consistent evaluation of vignettes at a reliability level of 0.70 is considered sufficient.

Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS-MH)
CANS Eligibility. At the time a nurse applies to sit for the certification exam, applicants must: Be currently licensed as a Registered Nurse in the United States, its territories or Canada, holding a current full and unrestricted license. Have spent at least 1,000 practice hours within the core specialties during the last two (2) years.
