The obverse of the 1996-type 1-yuan note is a portrait of two women from two minorities, and the reverse is the Great Wall. The obverse of the 1999-type 1-yuan note is a portrait of former Chinese leader Mao Zedong, while the reverse is the Xihu Lake in the southeastern Chinese city Hangzhou. The 2-yuan banknote is in green.

Chinese Paper Currency, Renminbi, China Yuan, Chinese ...

The fen (分 *fēn*), 1/100th of a yuan, is so seldom used now that fen coins and notes are almost out of circulation. Paper notes come in 1 and 5 jiao. 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 yuan denominations, though the 2 yuan note is rarely seen these days. There are also 1 jiao, 5 jiao and 1 yuan coins.

The Chinese may have invented the first metal coins, coins found in Anyang date to before 900 BC.
