The goal of the Guidelines is to protect the historical and architectural integrity of significant historic structures and landscapes in Santa Barbara.

Design Guidelines. The Historic Preservation Review Board (HPRB) and Historic Preservation Office (HPO) use written design standards and guidelines to review construction affecting historic properties in the District of Columbia. In some cases, HPRB and HPO also use the nationwide historic preservation standards and guidelines issued by the National Park Service (NPS).

Historic Preservation Design Guidelines - Houston

In addition to the above guidelines, historic buildings located in one of the City's Historic Districts or in the Downtown Design Review Overlay Zones may have more restrictions regarding location and how the mural is attached to the structure. The historic context of the structure should be maintained.

Historic Design Guidelines In considering whether to recommend approval or disapproval of an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness, the HDRC is guided by the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation , the City of San Antonio's Unified Development Code , and any additional design guidelines adopted by City Council, such as the Historic Design Guidelines and the Downtown Design Guide .

Historic and Design Review Commission (HDRC)

As new buildings are proposed, City code requires design and historic review for areas and individual buildings that are important to the city's growth and character. Design and historic design review evaluate proposals against the design guidelines applicable to the relevant area and type of proposal.
