Scientists differ on the number of species that can be distinguished, ranging from 25 to 40, although the current consensus is 33 known species.

Paeonia delavayi was collected at altitudes from 1,900 to 4,000 m, primarily in sparse thickets or dry Pinus and Quercus woods, rarely on grassy slopes or glades of virgin Picea forests. The taxon is endemic to China and restricted to western Sichuan, eastern Xizang (Tibet) and Yunnan. Plants of *Paeonia delavayi* are always dwarf shrubs.
