The Anabaptist Vision was the title of Harold S. Bender's presidential address to the American Society of Church History in 1942. Bender posited discipleship, i.e., following Jesus in life and under the cross, as the essence of Anabaptism, especially by comparison with Protestantism. He contrasted discipleship to faith ( Luther ), the first leading to patterns of Christian life, the second to theology.
