Value-focused thinking is an approach to structuring decisions by concentrating on the decision makers' values and preferences rather than the limited alternatives at hand. We describe how we used value-focused thinking to construct a model for measuring the current condition of an urban watershed, Upham Brook, in Richmond, Virginia.
